- Advocates for education-related legislative positions as developed and decided by the LAC (Legislative Action Committee) annually.
- Meets monthly throughout the school year 6:30–8:30 pm at Fairview Community Center Room 102 on the following Wednesdays for 2011-2012: 9/14, 10/5 or 10/19 (TBD), 11/9, 12/14, 1/11, 2/8, 3/14, 4/11, 5/2 or 5/16 (TBD), and 6/13.
