Policy 704 – Cable Communications

- 1.0 The School Board recognizes that cable communications have the potential for increasing the educational and informational opportunities for the students, staff and citizens of Independent School District 623 and encourages their use.
 - 1.1 Cable communications is defined as the transmission and/or retransmission of any electronic signal originating via videocassette, video disk, satellite TVRO earth station, character generator, interactive TV classroom, TV production studio or computer/data communications system, using the medium of fiber optic or coaxial cable (educational access cable television) for the intended reception and/or usage by staff, students, and district patrons.
- 2.0 This medium shall be used in an educationally sound and cost-effective manner for the students, staff and citizens within District 623.
- 3.0 Prior to initiating specific cable productions or transmissions, regulations will be established to govern such productions, within the guidelines of existing district policy.
- 4.0 Costs incurred in providing cable productions between facilities in District 623 and neighboring districts shall be borne in an equitable manner.
- 5.0 All operating procedures related to cable communications shall conform to existing district policies.
- 6.0 No copyrighted materials shall be broadcast from the district facilities without written approval from the publisher or producer of the materials.
- 7.0 All cable communication productions, including scripts, videotapes, and programs originating in District 623 using staff, equipment or facilities from the district, shall remain the property of Independent School District 623.
