RAHS After-School Expectations

We've determined the need to increase and clarify student after-school expectations. These expectations will be reinforced beginning Tuesday, Feb. 7.

All students deserve a safe and peaceful environment that is conducive to learning both inside and outside of the school day. RAHS will be instituting new expectations in order to better supervise and support students each day after school. RAHS will no longer be a gathering place for students to loiter after the school day. This expectation falls in line with other metro high schools.

- All students must exit RAHS by 3 p.m. each day unless they are supervised by RAHS staff:
 - Media Center is open M-TH from 3-4 p.m.
 - Classroom Teachers are available M-F from 3-3:30 p.m.
 - Athletic or Activity practice / rehearsal / group meeting / etc.
- 4 p.m. Activity shuttles are provided for students Monday - Thursday
 - 4 p.m. shuttle buses will now pick students up from the main entrance

Upon completion you will receive an email confirming your registration. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch and/or AVID will have all exam fees waived.
