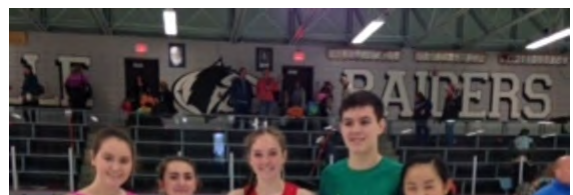
### School Newspaper - Raider Report

## From the Health Office

In light of recent news stories regarding **the measles cases in Minnesota**, this would be a good opportunity to make sure your student is fully immunized against this serious illness. A student needs two doses of the MMR vaccine to be fully immunized against measles, mumps and rubella.

We recommend you check with your student's health care provider to ensure immunizations are up to date. If you have chosen not to immunize your student and have submitted a signed conscientious exemption, it is a good time to discuss with your student's health care provider whether the MMR vaccine may be indicated.

Immunizations are available from your medical clinic, urgent care center, or for a low cost at the Ramsey County Public Health clinic. Call 651-266-1234 to make an appointment. We can also help make an appointment for you.

Please forward any additions to your student's immunization record to the school health office.
