On Monday, May 22 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fairview Community Center, Roseville Area Schools is hosting a community meeting about the district's facilities planning process.

Since last August, the district has worked with community members and staff members to look at the district's buildings and determine the greatest needs when it comes to issues from security, air quality, roofs, floors, and windows to how the district will address growing space needs with student enrollment projected to grow by more than 1,000 students in the next 10 years.

The plan evaluated needs at every school district building. Five key themes consistently emerged from community members and staff members:

- Safety and Security
- Physical Conditions
- Capacity
- Learning Spaces
- Community Spaces

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“The same emotional dynamics that may motivate a wrongdoer to express genuine remorse also may lead to authentic feelings of forgiveness on the part of those who are harmed. Again, none of these feelings can ever be forced, nor should there be any pressure or expectations placed on those who have been harmed to feel this way. These emotional shifts depend on the individuals involved and are part of their own journey. Experienced facilitators must learn to let go and let the participants do the work themselves. An experienced school Circle keeper says, “I am not looking for an apology, shame or blame. I want to know what actions can be done to repair the harm.”

RAMS Peb Suab – Hmong Club

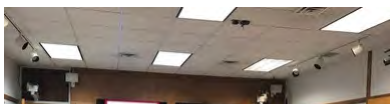
