### Fall Sports Meetings

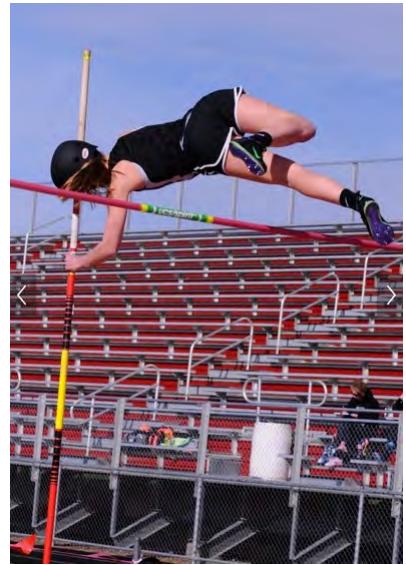

### Community Invited to May 22 Public Meeting about Facilities

Roseville Area Schools is hosting a community meeting about the district’s facilities planning process on Monday, May 22 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fairview Community Center, 1910 County Rd. B West.

Since last August, the district has worked with community members and staff members to look at the district’s buildings and determine the greatest needs when it comes to issues from security, air quality, roofs, floors, and windows to how the district will address growing space needs with student enrollment projected to grow by more than 1,000 students in the next 10 years.

The plan evaluated needs at every school district building. Five key themes consistently emerged from community members and staff members:

- Safety and Security

- Physical Conditions
- Capacity
- Learning Spaces
- Community Spaces
