Minnesota Reading & Math Corps: Tutors Needed

Central Park Elementary is seeking someone who is passionate about supporting students in literacy or math

We are looking for Minnesota Reading and Math Corps tutors for the 2017-18 school year at Central Park Elementary. As a tutor, you will have the opportunity to work with students every day, during the school day and help them become successful readers or mathematicians!

Minnesota Reading and Math Corps provide comprehensive training in strategies proven to help students build reading and math skills. Tutors are paid a living allowance and are eligible for up to \$5,815 to pay tuition or repay student loans. Tutors 55 or older may gift the award to a child or grandchild. Tutors may be eligible for free health insurance and child care assistance.
