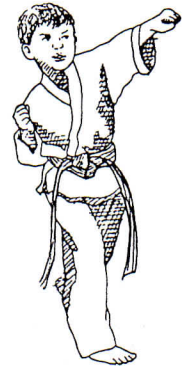
SELF-DEFENSE / AMERICAN KENPO KARATE
