ART SHOW

(All Grades; Non-Competitive)

Parkview's Media Center will turn into an art gallery:

- Prints, paintings, drawings, etchings, collages, photographs, computer graphics, sculptures, papier mâché, pottery & ceramics, book art, fiber art, etc.
- Art inspired by another artist's style, inspired by poetry, inspired by creative writing, inspired by PEACE.
- Art based on cultural traditions.

Participate

- Create art for display. No judging.
- Label each entry with your name and homeroom (for return after show).
- Deliver art to PCS Media Center on Jan. 30 or Jan. 31 (by noon).
- Write a title and a short "Artist's Statement" (a sentence or paragraph) to tell what inspires you and/or why you like art. Type or handwrite.
- Get a participant ribbon and certificate.

Participate

- Choose a project. Research ideas (online or library). Talk to teachers and parents. What do you want to learn about?
- Do research. Conduct experiments. Explain results and findings.
- Size it. Prepare a self-standing display no larger than 35 inches (wide) and 14 inches (deep).
- Receive additional information in January!
- **Be safe. NO hazardous chemicals, dry ice, live animals, open flames, or loud noises!**
