From Hwy 694: take the 10th St. exit. Right on 10th St. and left into the parking lot. the Big Thrill Factory is in the Bergen Plaza.

From Hwy 36: Lexington Parkway south into Como Park. There is parking on either side of the Lakeside Pavilion.

From Hwy 36: Take the Stillwater Blvd (Co Rd 14, Old Hwy 5) exit and head south. North parking lot will be on the left. Park and walk to the North gate entrance to get admission tickets and meet Ron.
