## *How to Give*

**There are two simple, tax-beneficial ways to include RASP in your will or estate plan:**

**1. Bequests:** In your will or estate plan, you can list a specific dollar amount, percentage of your estate, or the remainder of your estate as a legacy donation to the Roseville Area Senior Program. Contact us if you need our Federal EIN.

**Use the following language for bequests to the Roseville Area Senior Program:**

I [your name], give to Roseville Area Senior Program, 1910 County Road B West, Roseville MN. 55113, \_\_\_ percent of my estate, **OR** the sum of \_\_\_ dollars, **OR** the remainder of my estate.

**2. Beneficiary Designation:** Designate the Roseville Area Senior Program as a beneficiary in a life insurance policy or your retirement account. Contact us if you need our Federal EIN.

Designate Roseville Area Senior Program, and contact your insurance agent or financial planner to confirm your plans.
