Frequently Asked Questions

Do parents participate in classes?

Generally, PreK classes are for preschool students only. We do offer ECFE parent/child classes as an option for parents who are looking to be more involved. **For children who are 3 to 5 years old, Friday morning and Thursday evening ECFE classes will be offered in 2018-2019. Registration for ECFE classes is in June.**

How can I get more involved?

We offer family engagement nights, conferences, ECFE classes, advisory council, and other volunteer opportunities for parents.

Is transportation provided?

Transportation is available for most classes. Please let us know if transportation is needed on the registration form.

Why should I send my child to PreK?

PreK classes are designed to help 3-5 year olds prepare for school success. Classes are structured so that students become independent and successful learners while growing more comfortable in a school setting. Children may even be able to ride the bus to school and eat lunch with their peers!

Does my child need to be potty trained?

Children must be fully potty trained and independent in using the bathroom when entering PreK. Pullups or diapers are not allowed.

What is the class schedule?

Classes will start the week of September 10, 2018 and will run through June 6, 2019. PreK non-school days follow the Roseville Area Schools non-school day academic calendar.

Is financial assistance available?

What options are available?

- 2, 3, 4, or 5 half-days per week
- Morning, afternoon, and evening sessions
- All-day classes
- Multi-age classes for 3 to 5 year olds
- Bilingual classes (Spanish/English)
- Convenient locations at six sites in the Roseville Area School District

What is bilingual (Spanish/English) PreK?

The goal of our bilingual PreK classes is to support first languages while also exposing children to a second language. The Spanish/English classes provide an environment for peer learning and instruction and conversation in Spanish and English, which allow Spanish and English speaking children the opportunity to be exposed to a second language.

Is before- & after-school child care available?

Friendship Connection, the school-age child care program, is available for 4 and 5 year olds (one year before starting kindergarten) at Brimhall, Parkview Center School, Central Park, Harambee, and E. D. Williams. Limited care is available during Harambee Intersession. Friendship Connection registration is separate from PreK registration.

- 9 payments. The first payment is due with registration along with a \$50 non-refundable registration fee. Remaining payments due the 5th of the month October - May. (Harambee is 10 payments Oct.-June.)
- If a PreK class is cancelled before class begins, a full refund will be given minus the \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee.
- After September 10, 2018, a two-week cancellation is required and a prorated refund will be given minus the \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee.
