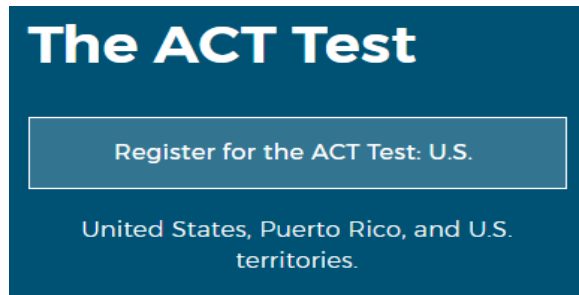


## \* \* \* ACT Registration Steps \* \* \*

For juniors and seniors that have taken the ACT at RAHS during spring of junior year.

Students who have taken the ACT at RAHS as a junior must go online and create an account **to register to take the ACT again**. Please go to the link below and follow the instructions to create an account, register for another test and link to your spring ACT test score:

Go to ACT.Org and click on “Register for the ACT Test: U.S.”



Then “Create US Account”

**PLEASE NOTE: It is VERY IMPORTANT that you enter the information exactly as you did for the April ACT.**

When you click "Continue" You will be asked to **enter your ACT ID – which is the 8-digit number** found on the top of your official score report.

ALL this information must match up exactly or you may run into a problem matching to the April test. If that happens, please call **ACT Student Support at 1-319-337-1270** and they will help you link your two accounts.
